BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there are more than 110 state boards and commissions under the

executive branch in the state; and

WHEREAS while some of these boards and commissions provide beneficial

12

services to the state, many do not provide any tangible benefits to the

13

state; and

WHEREAS many boards and commissions overlap in their function and

15

jurisdiction resulting in unnecessary duplication of effort; and

16

WHEREAS the current sunset law has proven ineffective in eliminating

17

the unnecessary and wasteful duplication of effort of boards and commis-

18

sions;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

20

the Governor to consolidate boards and commissions where feasible and

21

eliminate unnecessary boards and commissions and present a list of the

22

boards and commissions to be eliminated or consolidated to the legislature

23

no later than the first day of the second session of the Thirteenth Alaska

24

Legislature.
