Establishing a Joint Committee on the

public school foundation program.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the present public school foundation program needs to be
9 modified and improved; and

10

WHEREAS a thorough study should be done to provide these improvements;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the president of
12 the senate appoint three senators and the speaker of the house appoint
13 three representatives and the president and the speaker jointly appoint one
14 chairperson to a Joint Committee on the public school foundation program to
15 study and make recommendations for improving the public school foundation
16 program; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall report the scope of its
18 intended research to the legislature no later than May 31, 1983 and make a
19 final report to the legislature of its findings and recommendations no
20 later than February 1, 1984; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall have the power to call
22 witnesses, hold hearings, hire staff to perform its duties, and contract
23 for the performance of research; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is encouraged to hear witnesses
25 from the Alaska School Board Association, the Office of Management and
26 Budget, the Department of Education, the State Board of Education, the
27 Alaska Council of School Administrators, and other groups concerned with
28 state funding of education; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee terminates on February 1, 1984.
