5 Establishing a Joint House and Senate

6 Task Force on Subsistence.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS it is imperative that the Thirteenth Alaska State Legislature  
9 be completely informed of all aspects of the subsistence issue so that  
10 prompt and appropriate action can be taken; and

11 WHEREAS it is important to continue the work of the 1981 House Special  
12 on Subsistence and expand it to a Joint House and Senate Task Force; and

13 WHEREAS the purpose of the Joint House and Senate Task Force would be  
14 to examine the subsistence law to find ways to resolve the subsistence  
15 controversy for recommendation to the legislature for action;

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that a Joint House and  
17 Senate Task Force on Subsistence is established to examine the subsistence  
18 law and to make recommendations to the legislature for resolving the sub-  
19 sistence controversy; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the senate and the speaker of  
21 the house of representatives shall appoint not more than four members each  
22 to the Joint House and Senate Task Force from the State of Alaska who are  
23 concerned with subsistence but not members of the Alaska State Legislature;  
24 and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint House and Senate Task Force on Sub-  
26 sistence is authorized to meet during and between sessions of the legisla-  
27 ture, and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Four-  
28 teenth Legislature.
