BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS members and party caucuses of the Alaska State Legislature

9

have declared their desire to maintain a stable petroleum taxing policy in

10

Alaska; and

WHEREAS the state administration has declared its intention to pursue

12

the same taxing policy, and to promote development in the state in order to

13

reduce excessive dependence upon the petroleum industry; and

14

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the state and the petroleum

15

industry to foster amicable and harmonious relations and public good will;

and

WHEREAS a clear understanding of retail product pricing policies and

18

practices in the state by the petroleum industry could serve to promote

19

that good will and amicable, harmonious relations; and

20

WHEREAS there are wide disparities in retail petroleum prices in

21

various parts of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

23

the governor to obtain from oil industry representatives an explanation of

24

industry practices and policies, including numeric and other factors

25

involved in establishing retail petroleum prices in the state and the

26

extent to which each affects final retail prices, for dissemination to the

27

people of Alaska.
