BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the eighteenth annual Boys' State will be held June 2 - 9,

1984, at Camp Carroll (Fort Richardson) under the sponsorship of the

American Legion and cooperating organizations; and

WHEREAS this fine annual program of the American Legion ranks high

among the efforts of several Alaskan organizations to bring to the youth

delegates an awareness of their future roles in state and local government;

WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Boys' State at Camp

Carroll is made possible by an admirable combination of volunteer service
