name "Little Goat Lake" near Ketchikan

as "Ed Todd Lake."

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS an unnamed lake near Ketchikan is locally called Little Goat

10 Lake; and

WHEREAS Ed Todd lost his life in an airplane accident near Little Goat

12 Lake; and

13

WHEREAS Ed Todd was a man well-respected within the Ketchikan commu-

14 nity during his life; and

15

WHEREAS Ed Todd was the founder of Todd's Air Service in Ketchikan in

16 1944 and the operator of the air service during the remainder of his life;

17 and

WHEREAS Ed Todd spent almost all of his 59 years in the state before

19 his untimely death; and

WHEREAS Ed Todd participated in many hours of search and rescue work

21 during his lifetime; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate that a geographic feature within the

23 Ketchikan area be named in his honor as permanent testimony to his memory;

24 and

WHEREAS Little Goat Lake was a favorite goat hunting area for Ed Todd

26 during his lifetime;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the State Geo-

28 graphic Board is requested to name "Little Goat Lake" as "Ed Todd Lake."
