5 Requesting the State Geographic Board to
6 name an unnamed lake near Ketchikan as
7 "Ed Todd Lake."

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Ed Todd lost his life in an airplane accident in an unnamed
10 lake near Big Goat Lake; and

11 WHEREAS Ed Todd was a man well-respected within the Ketchikan commu-
12 nity during his life; and

13 WHEREAS Ed Todd was the founder of Todd's Air Service in Ketchikan in
14 1944 and the operator of the air service during the remainder of his life;
15 and

16 WHEREAS Ed Todd spent almost all of his 59 years in the state before
17 his untimely death; and

18 WHEREAS Ed Todd participated in many hours of search and rescue work
19 during his lifetime; and

20 WHEREAS it is appropriate that a geographic feature within the
21 Ketchikan area be named in his honor as permanent testimony to his memory;
22 and

23 WHEREAS the unnamed lake near Big Goat Lake was a favorite goat hunt-
24 ing area for Ed Todd during his lifetime; and

25 WHEREAS the unnamed lake is located about two or three miles north of
26 Big Goat Lake, is approximately 100 miles east of Ketchikan, and is located
27 in sections 1 and 12, Township 73 South, Range 97 East, Copper River
28 Meridian;

29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the State
