7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Alaska workplace is rapidly changing as technological
9 advances occur, but the one need that does not change is the need to ensure
10 that workers have safe places to work; and

11 WHEREAS employers and workers recognize that job-related injuries and
12 illnesses are a major problem in the workplace; and

13 WHEREAS a major contribution can be made to encourage occupational
14 safety and health by making employers and workers aware of the need to
15 practice safety and health measures on the job; and

16 WHEREAS the legislature is convinced that greater safety awareness can
17 be achieved through the declaration of a week promoting occupational safety
18 in the workplace;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governor is
20 requested to declare June 24 to June 30, 1984, as "Safety in the Workplace
21 Week" and to urge employers and workers to promote safety and health aware-
22 ness on the job.
