tion of the State of Alaska relating to  
elections for candidates for the offices  
of governor and lieutenant governor.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Article III, sec. 3, Constitution of the State of Alaska,  
11 is amended to read:

12 SECTION 3. ELECTION. (a) Except as provided in (b) and (c) of  
13 this section, the [THE] governor shall be chosen by the qualified  
14 voters of the state at a general election. Except as provided in (b)  
15 and (c) of this section, the [THE] candidate receiving the greatest  
16 number of votes shall be governor.

17 (b) If in the general election no candidate receives 50 percent  
18 of the votes cast for governor plus one vote, a runoff election shall  
19 be held between the candidate receiving the greatest number of votes  
20 and the candidate receiving the second greatest number of votes. The  
21 candidate receiving the greater number of votes in the runoff election  
22 shall be governor.

23 (c) A runoff election under this section shall be held on the  
24 first Tuesday occurring two weeks after the date of the certification  
25 of the results of the general election but not later than the last  
26 Tuesday in November.

27 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
28 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
29 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the

1 election laws of the state.
