8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. Article II, sec. 7, Constitution of the State of Alaska,

10 is amended to read:

11 SECTION 7. Legislators shall receive annual salaries. They may  
12 receive a per diem allowance for expenses while in session and are  
13 entitled to travel expenses going to and from sessions. Presiding  
14 officers may receive additional compensation. An increase in legisla-  
15 tors' remuneration is not effective until the legislature first con-  
16 venes in regular session after the general election following enact-  
17 ment of the change.

18 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
20 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-  
21 tion laws of the state.
