9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Article X, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is
11 amended to read:

12 Section 8. The legislature may provide for a city to be governed
13 as a direct democracy. Unless the city is a direct democracy, the
14 [THE] governing body of a city shall be the council.

15 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
16 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
17 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
18 tion laws of the state.
