2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 62

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting Congress to appropriate money
6 to the Small Business Administration as
7 authorized in P.L. 93-237.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS in 1974 Congress enacted P.L. 93-237 (87 Stat. 1023) entitled
10 "An Act to amend the Small Business Act"; and

11 WHEREAS P.L. 93-237 amends the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.A. sec.
12 633) to increase the total amount of loans, guarantees, and other obliga-
13 tions and commitments outstanding by the Small Business Administration; and

14 WHEREAS P.L. 93-237 represents neither an appropriation of money nor
15 an authorization for appropriations but rather merely allows the Small
16 Business Administration to increase its loan ceilings so that it may spend
17 money that it will obtain through the appropriation process or through
18 repayment of prior loans; and

19 WHEREAS Congress has failed to appropriate money to the Small Business
20 Administration which permits it to fully implement its higher lending
21 authority authorized by P.L. 93-237; and

22 WHEREAS the development of and assistance to small businesses is
23 important to the economy of the state;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
25 Congress to appropriate the money necessary to fully implement P.L. 93-237.

27 Hatfield, Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee; the Honorable
28 Jamie L. Whitten, Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee; and to

2 delegation in Congress.
