8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. Article II, sec. 3, Constitution of the State of Alaska is  
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 3. ELECTION AND TERMS. Legislators shall be elected at  
12 general elections. Their terms begin on the fourth Monday of the  
13 January following election unless otherwise provided by law. The term  
14 of representatives shall be four [TWO] years, and the term of sena-  
15 tors, six [FOUR] years. One-half of the representatives and six of  
16 the senators shall be elected every two years. Two additional sena-  
17 tors shall be elected at the first general election held after the  
18 effective date of this amendment and each sixth year thereafter. A  
19 representative may not serve more than two consecutive full four-year  
20 terms. A senator may not serve more than two consecutive full six-  
21 year terms.

22 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
23 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
24 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-  
25 tion laws of the state.
