7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska played a significant role in World War II because of

9

its strategic location; and

10

WHEREAS many Alaskans fought in World War II and many Americans from

11

other states spent periods of time in Alaska as part of the war effort; and

12

WHEREAS the people of the United States and of Alaska have an interest

13

in the preservation of artifacts from World War II to remind them of this

14

cataclysmic event in the history of our nation; and

15

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has the primary concern in the

16

preservation of artifacts of historical significance found in the state;

17

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests the federal

18

government not to remove World War II artifacts of historical significance

19

from Alaska but to make them available for preservation in museums in the

20

state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests Congress

22

to make it illegal to remove from Alaska a vehicle, aircraft, watercraft,

23

or weapon used during World War II for the purpose of conducting the war

24

unless the removal is authorized by the federal or state government or

25

unless the artifact is determined by the federal or state government to be

26

hazardous to human or animal life in the area in which it is located.
