Relating to creation of a special com-

mittee on residency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS residency requirements of the original permanent fund dis-

9

tribution plan were overturned by the United States Supreme Court; and

10

WHEREAS residency requirements relating to student loans and the state

11

longevity bonus have been challenged in Alaska courts; and

12

WHEREAS a wide variety of state programs contain residency require-

13

ments that have been called into question by recent court decisions; and

14

WHEREAS in the case of one or more state programs, court action has

15

been delayed so that the legislature may deal with the issue of residency

16

in general; and

17

WHEREAS this is an issue of overriding state importance;

18

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska House of Representatives creates a

19

special committee on residency consisting of five members appointed by the

20

speaker of the house to study the issue and make recommendations to the

21

legislature; and be it

22

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and

23

between sessions of the legislature and shall terminate January 20, 1985.
