Special Committee on Veterans Affairs.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS veterans have unique experiences resulting from their military
9 service on behalf of the country and may have problems deriving from those
10 experiences; and

11 WHEREAS many veterans are often unaware of the rights and opportuni-
12 ties afforded them because of their status as veterans; and

13 WHEREAS there is no single committee of the House of Representatives
14 charged with considering veterans affairs and therefore information from
15 veterans and veterans' groups is not directed to the house in a coordinated
16 fashion;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special
18 Committee on Veterans Affairs is established to study, take testimony, and
19 make proposals on veterans issues; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the house shall appoint no more
21 than five representatives to be members of the committee and shall desig-
22 nate a member to chair the committee; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and
24 between sessions of the legislature and shall terminate January 1, 1985.
