5 Relating to the establishment of a House
6 Special Committee on Veterans' Affairs.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS veterans have unique experiences resulting from their military
9 service on behalf of the country and may have problems deriving from those
10 experiences; and

11 WHEREAS many veterans are often unaware of the rights and opportuni-
12 ties afforded them because of their status as veterans;

13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special
14 Committee on Veterans' Affairs is established; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the house shall appoint no more
16 than five representatives to be members of the committee and shall desig-
17 nate a member to chair the committee; and be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and
19 between sessions of the legislature and shall terminate January 1, 1985.
