6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the Alaska
7 Power Authority; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$60,451,000 is appropriated from the general
11 fund to the Alaska Power Authority for the purposes expressed and in the
12 amounts listed, for capital projects:

13 Anchorage-Fairbanks Intertie (construction)	\$ 25,000,000
14 Susitna River hydroelectric project (studies and	
15 licensing)	22,000,000
16 Rural project reconnaissance (studies)	1,000,000
17 Kake-Petersburg intertie (design)	545,000
18 Lower Kuskokwim/Bristol Bay hydroelectric project	
19 (feasibility study)	2,000,000
20 Pelican hydroelectric project (construction)	3,074,000
21 Rural waste heat/alternative energy projects	
22 (construction)	5,000,000
23 Cordova/Silver Lake hydroelectric project (study)	832,000
24 Kotzebue coal project (study)	1,000,000

25 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$130,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
26 the power project fund in the Alaska Power Authority (AS 44.83.170) for a
27 loan to the City of Thorne Bay for the purchase of an electrical generating
28 facility.

29 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund

1 to the rural electrification revolving loan fund (AS 44.83.361) in the
2 Alaska Power Authority.

3 * Sec. 4. The appropriation made by sec. 3 of this Act is for capitali-
4 zation of a loan fund and does not lapse in accordance with AS 37.25.010.

5 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1983.
