8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
9 \* Section 1. AS 11.46.400(a) is amended to read:  
10 (a) A person commits the crime of arson in the first degree if  
11 the person [HE] intentionally damages any property by starting a fire  
12 or causing an explosion and by that act recklessly places another  
13 person in danger of serious physical injury. For purposes of this  
14 section, "another person" includes but is not limited to fire and  
15 police service personnel or other public employees who respond to  
16 emergencies, regardless of rank, functions, or duties being performed.
