6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for certain
7 capital projects and planning for elementary and
8 secondary educational facilities; and providing for
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$70,250,310 is appropriated from the general
12 fund to the Department of Education for payment as grants to the following
13 school districts for the purposes expressed and in the amounts listed, for
14 capital projects:
