A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing persons 16 years of age or older
7 to be present in certain premises that serve alco-
8 holic beverages."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.16.049(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) A person under the age of 19 years may not knowingly enter
12 or remain in premises licensed under this title unless

13 (1) accompanied by a parent, guardian or spouse who has at-
14 tained the age of 19 years; or

15 (2) the person is at least 16 years of age, and [ACCOM-
16 PANIED BY A PERSON OVER THE AGE OF 19 YEARS AND WITH THE CONSENT OF
17 THE PERSON'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN IF] the premises are designated by the
18 board as a restaurant for the purposes of this section [AND THE PER-
19 SONS ENTER AND REMAIN ONLY FOR DINING].

20 * Sec. 2. AS 04.16.049(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

21 (b) A licensee or an agent or employee of a licensee may exclude
22 a person under the age of 19 years from a part of licensed premises
23 designated by the board as a restaurant if that part is used primarily
24 for the consumption of alcoholic beverages and not for dining,
25 dancing, or other entertainment.
