6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to access by persons under 19 years
7 of age to certain premises that serve alcoholic
8 beverages."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.16.049(a)(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) accompanied by a person over the age of 19 years and
12 with the consent of the person's parent or guardian if the premises
13 are designated by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this
14 paragraph [SECTION] and the persons enter and remain only for dining;
15 [.]

16 * Sec. 2. AS 04.16.049(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (3) the premises are certified as a restaurant under (d) of
18 this section and the person enters and remains only for dining.

19 * Sec. 3. AS 04.16.049 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (d) The board may certify licensed premises as a restaurant for
21 the purpose of (a)(3) of this section if

22 (1) a licensee applies for certification in the manner
23 required by the board;

24 (2) after inspecting the premises the board determines that
25 serving food for consumption on the premises is a primary business
26 conducted in the premises;

27 (3) the governing body of the municipality approves certi-
28 fication of the premises by resolution if the premises are located in
29 a municipality.
