6 For an Act entitled: "An Act allowing a retirement credit for certain  
7 leaves of absence; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.345(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) A leave of absence is not an interruption of the continuous  
12 service necessary to attain or retain retirement or tenure rights  
13 according to AS 14.20.150, 14.20.155, or 14.20.160. However, the time  
14 spent on leave of absence may not be counted in determining when a  
15 teacher has sufficient service to enable the teacher to acquire re-  
16 tirement or tenure rights, except that time on leave of absence for  
17 specific educational purposes approved by a school board may be  
18 counted as membership service to complete the requirements for retire-  
19 ment under AS 14.25.110, if the teacher makes contributions for the  
20 period of the leave of absence under (d) of this section.
