BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.56 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.56.725. OBSTRUCTING A PRIVATE CITIZEN WHO ASSISTS A

PEACE OFFICER OR JUDICIAL OFFICER. (a) A person commits the crime of

13

obstructing a private citizen who assists a peace officer or judicial

14

officer if, knowing that the private citizen is assisting a peace

15

officer or judicial officer in the performance of official duties

16

voluntarily or at the request of the officer, with intent to obstruct

17

the performance of the official duties or to retaliate for assistance

18

rendered, the person commits an offense punishable under AS 11 as a

19

misdemeanor or a felony.

(b) A person who violates (a) of this section is guilty of a

21

class C felony.
