BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.20.085. MAXIMUM MONTHLY SALARY. (a) The base monthly salary, including adjustments for longevity, of an official or employee of a state agency may not be greater than the monthly salary of governor under AS 39.20.010.

(b) In this section

(1) "state agency" means a department, office, agency, state board, commission, public corporation or other organizational unit of or created under the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of state government, including the University of Alaska;

(2) "employee" means a person employed by a state agency;

(3) "official" means the appointive head of a state agency.

\* Sec. 2. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.27.016. COST OF LIVING SURVEY. The director of the division of personnel shall conduct an annual cost of living survey and make, no later than the 30th day of the legislative session, recommendations in pay ranges to be applied to all classes of positions in the state's exempt and partially exempt service including the University of Alaska. This survey shall be considered by the state in collective bargaining negotiation concerning classified employees.
