A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employment preferences for state
7 residents in construction contracts by the state or
8 an agency of the state; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 36.10.010 is repealed and reenacted to read:

12 Sec. 36.10.010. EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. When a construction
13 project is wholly funded by state money and the state or an agency of
14 the state is a signatory to the construction contract, the contract
15 shall require that the worker hours on a craft-by-craft basis shall be
16 performed at least 50 percent by bona fide state residents. In an
17 area which has been designated as an area impacted by an economic
18 disaster, residents of that area shall be given employment preference
19 as provided in AS 44.33.290, followed by other residents of the state.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
21 10.070(c).
