9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
10 * Section 1. AS 21.36.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:
12 (d) A person may not make or permit unfair discrimination
13 against a person who provides a service covered under a group dis-
14 ability policy that extends coverage on an expense incurred basis, or
15 under a group service or indemnity type contract issued by a nonprofit
16 corporation, if the service is within the scope of the provider's
17 occupational license. In this subsection, "provider" means a state
18 licensed physician, dentist, osteopath, optometrist, chiropractor or
19 nurse midwife.
* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1984.
