6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the delegation of department head
7 membership on boards, commissions, and other units of
8 the state government."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.17.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:

12 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a principal
13 executive officer of a state department who is appointed to serve as a
14 member of a board, commission, public authority, public corporation,
15 or other unit of state government may assign the duties, powers, and
16 privileges of the membership to a subordinate employee who has status
17 at least equivalent to division director, subject to the approval of
18 the governor. A delegation of membership under this subsection must
19 be in writing and is effective until the principal executive officer
20 revokes the delegation, resigns or otherwise forfeits office, or is no
21 longer qualified to be a member.
