A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to competitive bidding for travel
7 contracts."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.05.230(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) a contract for construction and repairs, or a purchase
11 of and contract for supplies, materials, equipment, travel, and con-
12 tractual services must be based on competitive bids; an award shall be
13 made to the lowest responsible bidder after advertising for bids,
14 except that

15 (A) Repealed by sec. 2 ch 92 SLA 1967;

16 (B) a bid shall be awarded to an Alaska bidder if the
17 [HIS] bid is not more than five percent higher than the lowest
18 nonresident bidder's; and

19 (C) competitive bids need not be required

20 (i) for contractual services where no competition
21 exists;

22 (ii) for sales involving fair trade items;

23 (iii) when, in the judgment of the purchasing
24 agent, food, clothing, or medical supplies, or materials for
25 use in laboratory and experimental studies may be purchased
26 otherwise to the best advantage of the state;

27 (iv) where rates are fixed by law or ordinance;

28 (v) for items traded in on like items; or

29 (vi) for professional services;
