Sec. 09.60.010. COSTS ALLOWED PREVAILING PARTY. (a) Except as

otherwise provided by statute, the supreme court shall determine by

13

rule or order what costs, if any, including attorney fees, shall be

14

allowed the prevailing party in any case.

(b) The supreme court shall by rule or order provide that the

16

court in its discretion may compel a plaintiff in an action to post a

17

bond or other acceptable surety with the court in an amount determined

18

by the court to be reasonable under (a) of this section.
