A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska longevity bonus; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. A person who is 65 years of age or over and who has main-
10 tained a continuous domicile in the state for one year before the effective
11 date of this Act may apply to the commissioner of administration for quali-
12 fication to receive a monthly bonus of \$250 under the provisions of former
13 AS 47.45 repealed by sec. 2 of this Act.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 47.45 is repealed except as it applies to persons who on
15 the effective date of this Act meet the qualifications established in sec.
16 1 of this Act. The provisions of AS 47.45 continue to apply to those per-
17 sons.

18 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
19 10.070(c).
