A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to mining lease locations."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. Section 5, chapter 108, SLA 1981, is amended to read:

9 Sec. 5. SPECIAL PROVISION FOR MINING LEASE LOCATIONS. Notwith-
10 standing AS 38.05.205(a), until December 31, 1985 [1983], minerals may
11 be mined, marketed, or used on a location for mineral leasing under
12 AS 38.05.205 on state land [TENTATIVELY APPROVED OR PATENTED TO THE
13 STATE UNDER SECTION 6(a) OR 6(b) OF THE ALASKA STATEHOOD ACT (P.L. 85-
14 508, 72 STAT. 339, AS AMENDED)] upon discovery, location, and record-
15 ing in accordance with AS 38.05.195. However, this section does not
16 apply to a locator who does not file an application for a lease within
17 90 days after receipt of the application form as required by AS 38.-
18 05.205.
