6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state indemnification under the  
7 seafood processing permit program; and providing for  
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 03.05.025 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
11 read:

12 (c) A seafood processing permit may not be issued to a person  
13 unless that person agrees to indemnify the state and its agents and  
14 employees and hold them harmless from all claims for injuries result-  
15 ing from consumption of the permittee's product.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 03.05.026(e) is amended to read:

17 (e) A person may not display a seal under this section without  
18 authorization from the commissioner of environmental conservation.  
19 The commissioner may condition the granting of that authorization upon  
20 proof of insurance coverage in an amount that the commissioner consid-  
21 ers adequate to assure the permittee's ability to indemnify the state  
22 as provided in AS 03.05.025(c).
