A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Fisheries."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.05.221(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) For purposes of the conservation and development of the
10 fishery resources of the state, there is created the Board of Fisher-
11 ies composed of seven members appointed by the governor, subject to
12 confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint
13 session. The appointed members shall be residents of the state and
14 shall be appointed without regard to political affiliation [OR GEOGRA-
15 PHICAL LOCATION OF RESIDENCE]. The commissioner is not a member of
16 the Board of Fisheries, but shall be ex officio secretary. At least
17 one member shall reside in each of the following areas:

- 18 (1) the First Judicial District;
19 (2) the Second Judicial District;
20 (3) the Municipality of Anchorage; and
21 (4) the Fairbanks North Star Borough.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.221 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

23 (c) The geographic representation on the Board of Fisheries
24 required by (a) of this section applies only to appointments made
25 after the effective date of this Act.
