6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to discharge of firearms, and hunt-
7 ing and fishing in state park and recreation areas."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.20.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:

11 (b) The department may not restrict fishing, hunting or trapping
12 within the boundaries of a state park or recreation area permitted
13 under law or under a regulation of the Board of Game or Board of
14 Fisheries. The lawful discharge of a firearm is permitted within the
15 boundaries of a state park or recreation area unless all or a portion
16 of the state park or recreation area is closed to the discharge of a
17 firearm by regulation of the department for public safety purposes.
