A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to discharge of firearms, and hunt-
7 ing and fishing in state parks, marine parks,
8 wildlife preserves, and recreation areas."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 41.21.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:

12 (b) The department may not restrict fishing, hunting or trapping
13 within the boundaries of a state park, marine park, wildlife preserve,
14 or recreation area permitted under law or under a regulation of the
15 Board of Game or Board of Fisheries. The lawful discharge of a
16 firearm is permitted within the boundaries of a state park, marine
17 park, wildlife preserve, or recreation area unless all or a portion of
18 the state park, marine park, wildlife preserve, or recreation area is
19 closed to the discharge of a firearm by regulation adopted by the
20 Department of Public Safety for public safety purposes or public
21 display of local wildlife.
