A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to residents of the Alaska Pioneers'
7 Home."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.25.020(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) Every person admitted to the Pioneers' Home, except a person
11 admitted under AS 47.25.030, who receives income from any source in
12 excess of \$100 per [\$35 A] month may be required by the Department of
13 Administration to pay the excess to the Department of Administration
14 immediately upon receipt of the money in payment, or part payment, of
15 the cost of the person's [HIS] maintenance.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 47.25.020(c) is amended to read:

17 (c) At the end of each month the payments made under (b) of this
18 section shall be transmitted to the commissioner of revenue together
19 with the names of the persons making them and the amount paid by each.
20 The Department of Administration may pay the sum of \$100 per [\$35 A]
21 month to a resident without funds.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 47.25.070(c) is repealed and reenacted to read:

23 (c) The clothing and other personal effects left by a deceased
24 resident of the home shall be given to the guardian of the deceased
25 upon request. If there is no guardian, a relative of the deceased may
26 request the clothing and other personal effects. Clothing and effects
27 not claimed by a guardian or a relative of the resident within 30 days
28 after the resident's death may be used for the benefit of other
29 residents, or sold and the proceeds applied in the manner provided for

1 money left by a deceased resident.
