A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to impact payments to municipali-  
7 ties; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 38.95 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 5. IMPACT PAYMENTS TO MUNICIPALITIES.

11 Sec. 38.95.200. IMPACT PAYMENTS. (a) During each quarter of  
12 the year the department shall determine the amount of land owned in  
13 fee by the state and located within the boundaries of a municipality  
14 that was sold during the previous quarter. The department shall  
15 compute an impact payment in accordance with (b) of this section to  
16 partially compensate the municipality for the impact the sale of state  
17 land has on the cost of providing municipal services. The department  
18 shall provide a statement of the number of acres of land located  
19 within the municipality sold by the state during the previous quarter  
20 to each municipality together with the impact payment.

21 (b) An impact payment for a unified municipality or a city shall  
22 equal \$200 for each acre of land located within the municipality and  
23 sold by the state during the previous quarter. An impact payment for  
24 a borough shall equal \$200 for each acre of land located within the  
25 borough but outside of a city and sold by the state during the previ-  
26 ous quarter.

27 Sec. 38.95.210. IMPACT FUND. (a) The impact fund is estab-  
28 lished in the department. Money to carry out the provisions of  
29 AS 38.95.200 shall be appropriated to the account and distributed as

1 impact payments by the department.

2 (b) Each fiscal year the department shall estimate the amount of  
3 money that will be needed to fund all impact payments during the next  
4 fiscal year and shall request an appropriation of that amount from the  
5 legislature. If the amount appropriated to the account is not suffi-  
6 cient to finance impact payments during a quarter, the money shall be  
7 distributed pro rata among the municipalities that qualify for pay-  
8 ments.

9 Sec. 38.95.220. DEFINITIONS. In AS 38.95.200 - 38.95.220  
10 "department" means the Department of Natural Resources.

11 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1984.
