6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to agricultural and industrial
7 fairs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 03.20.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:

11 (d) In order to receive funds as an agricultural and industrial
12 fair, a fair shall include competitive exhibits

13 (1) by a 4-H club or a Future Farmers of America chapter;

14 (2) relating to agriculture, industry, horticulture, native
15 plants or livestock;

16 (3) indicating past, present, or future potential of a
17 renewable resource that is related to the community, region, or state;

18 (4) showing household arts; and

19 (5) including general interest subjects such as hobbies,
20 arts, crafts, photography, and school education.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 03.20.080(1) is amended to read:

22 (1) "agricultural and industrial fair" means a community,
23 regional or state fair that includes in its activities exhibits of
24 agriculture, industry, horticulture, native plants, livestock, and
25 related domestic arts produced in the community, region, or state [,
26 THE MAJOR FOCUS OF WHICH IS DISPLAYS, EXHIBITIONS, DEMONSTRATIONS,
27 CONTESTS OR PROMOTIONS OF AGRICULTURAL OR INDUSTRIAL CONCERN TO THE
28 REGION IN WHICH THE FAIR IS LOCATED, OR ANY FAIR WHICH, BEFORE JULY 1,
29 1980, HAS RECEIVED A GRANT UNDER THIS CHAPTER];
