6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to discriminatory conduct."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 09.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 ARTICLE 8. DISCRIMINATORY HARASSMENT.

10 Sec. 09.55.650. DISCRIMINATORY HARASSMENT ACTION. (a) A person
11 has a civil action for discriminatory harassment against a person, or
12 against the parent or legal guardian of a minor, who, without the
13 right to do so or a reasonable ground to believe a right to do so
14 exists, and with the intent to intimidate, harass, or injure another
15 person because of the sex, race, color, religion, creed, ancestry,
16 national origin, mental handicap, or physical handicap of that person,

17 (1) causes physical injury to a person; or

18 (2) causes property damage.

19 (b) The court may award actual and punitive damages to a pre-
20 vailing plaintiff in an action brought under this section. An award
21 of damages against the parent or legal guardian of a minor under this
22 section shall be predicated on conduct of the parent or legal guardian
23 that is at least negligent. An award of damages under this section
24 does not preclude a person from seeking other remedies available under
25 law.
