6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making an appropriation to the Department of
7 Environmental Conservation for water and sewer
8 grants, and special appropriations for payment as
9 grants to municipalities and unincorporated commu-
10 nities for water, sewer, and solid waste grants; and
11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 * Section 1. The appropriations made by sec. 2 of this Act are for
14 capital projects or are otherwise not one-year appropriations and do not
15 lapse under AS 37.25.010.
