A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to election campaign contributions  
7 and expenditures; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 15.13.040(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) Each candidate shall make a full report, upon a form pre-  
12 scribed by the commission, listing the date and amount of all expendi-  
13 tures made by the candidate, the total amount of all contributions,  
14 including all funds contributed by the candidate himself, and for all  
15 contributions in excess of \$250 [100] in the aggregate a year, the  
16 name, address, principal occupation, and employer of the contributor  
17 and the date and amount contributed by each contributor. The report  
18 shall be filed in accordance with AS 15.13.110 and shall be certified  
19 correct by the candidate or campaign treasurer.

20 \* Sec. 2. AS 15.13.040(b)(2) is amended to read:

21 (2) the aggregate amount of all contributions made to it;  
22 and, for all contributions in excess of \$250 [100] in the aggregate a  
23 year, the name, address, principal occupation, and employer of the  
24 contributor, and the date and amount contributed by each contributor;

26 \* Sec. 3. AS 15.13.040(d)(1) is amended to read:

27 (1) any contribution of cash, goods or services valued at  
28 more than \$250 [100] a year to any group or candidate; or

29 \* Sec. 4. AS 15.13.070(a) is amended to read:

1           (a) No person or group, including but not limited to all politi-  
2 cal committees, businesses, corporations, and labor unions, may con-  
3 tribute [TO OR EXPEND] more than \$2,000 [1,000] a year on behalf of or  
4 in opposition to the competing candidates for each elective office.  
5 Political parties and their subdivisions are not subject to the limi-  
6 tation prescribed in this subsection, but they are subject to the  
7 reporting requirements prescribed by AS 15.13.040(b) and 15.13.110.  
8 Nothing in the chapter prohibits

9           (1) a candidate from contributing more than \$2,000 [1,000]  
10 of his own money to his own campaign; or

11           (2) individuals or groups, including but not limited to all  
12 political committees, businesses, corporations, and labor unions, from  
13 contributing [TO OR EXPENDING] on behalf of a ballot proposition or  
14 question more than \$2,000 [1,000] a year; however, these contributions  
15 and expenditures shall be reported in accordance with AS 15.13.040 and  
16 15.13.110.
