6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the State Board of Registration  
7 for Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.03.010(c)(15) is amended to read:

11 (15) State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers,  
12 and Land Surveyors (AS 08.48.011) -- June 30, 1988 [1984].

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.48.011(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) The board consists of nine members appointed by the governor  
15 having the qualifications as set out in AS 08.48.031. The board  
16 consists of two civil engineers, one land surveyor, one mining  
17 engineer, two engineers from other branches of the profession of  
18 engineering, two [AND THREE] architects, and one public member.

19 \* Sec. 3. AS 08.48.021(b) is amended to read:

20 (b) The term of office for board members is four [SIX] years. A  
21 person who has served two successive complete terms may not be reap-  
22 pointed until four years from the expiration of the second term. [THE  
23 FIRST BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED WITH TWO MEMBERS HAVING TWO-YEAR TERMS,  
24 TWO MEMBERS HAVING THREE-YEAR TERMS, TWO MEMBERS HAVING FOUR-YEAR  
25 TERMS, ONE MEMBER HAVING A FIVE-YEAR TERM AND TWO MEMBERS HAVING  
26 SIX-YEAR TERMS. A MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY BE APPOINTED TO SUCCESSIVE  
27 TERMS.] Each member shall hold office until the expiration of the  
28 term for which the member is appointed or until the member's successor  
29 has been appointed. If a vacancy occurs on the board due to

1 resignation, death or other cause, the governor shall appoint a quali-  
2 fied person to serve the unexpired term.

3 \* Sec. 4. AS 08.48.031 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 08.48.031. QUALIFICATIONS. Each member of the board must  
5 have been a resident in the state for three consecutive years immedi-  
6 ately preceding appointment and, except for the public member, must be  
7 registered and have a minimum of five years of professional practice  
8 in the member's respective field.

9 \* Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the amendments made to AS 08.48.011 by sec. 2  
10 of this Act, a member of the board on the effective date of this Act may  
11 continue on the board until resigning or until expiration of the member's  
12 term.

13 \* Sec. 6. Notwithstanding the amendments made to AS 08.48.021 by sec. 3  
14 of this Act, a member of the board on the effective date of this Act may  
15 continue on the board for the number of years for which the member was  
16 originally appointed.

17 \* Sec. 7. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-  
18 10.070(c).
