A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act applying the computation of good time to
7 incarcerated prisoners who have been convicted of an
8 offense against a political subdivision."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 33.20.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 33.20.010. COMPUTATION OF GOOD TIME. Notwithstanding
12 AS 12.55.125(f)(3) and (g)(3), each prisoner convicted of an offense
13 against the state or a political subdivision and sentenced to
14 imprisonment, whose record of conduct shows that the prisoner has
15 faithfully observed the rules of the institution in which the prisoner
16 is confined, is entitled to a deduction from the term of imprisonment
17 of one day for every three days of good conduct served.
