A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registered voter information and
7 its confidentiality."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15.07.060(a) is repealed and reenacted to read:

10 (a) Each applicant who requests registration or reregistration
11 shall supply the following information under oath:

12 (1) name;

13 (2) mailing address;

14 (3) sex;

15 (4) party affiliation, if any;

16 (5) residence address;

17 (6) date and place of birth;

18 (7) declaration that the applicant is a citizen of the
19 United States;

20 (8) date of naturalization, if a naturalized citizen;

21 (9) length of residence in the state;

22 (10) length of residence in the election district;

23 (11) other jurisdictions in which the applicant is currently
24 registered to vote;

25 (12) date of application;

26 (13) signature or mark.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 15.07.060 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

28 (e) The director may request the disclosure of the social secur-
29 ity account number assigned to the applicant after informing the

1 applicant that the disclosure is optional and that, if disclosed, the
2 account number will be used only by the division of elections or a
3 municipal election official to verify the applicant's identity or by
4 state agencies other than the division of elections to ascertain or
5 prove the applicant's identity or the applicant's eligibility or in-
6 eligibility for a state permit, license, loan, or other benefit. The
7 number may be used only for these purposes.

8 (f) Information required to be supplied under (a)(1) -- (4) of
9 this section is public information.

10 (g) Information required to be supplied under (a)(5) -- (13) of
11 this section is not public information. However, it may be disclosed
12 to municipal election officials to verify a voter's identity and may
13 be disclosed to state agencies other than the division of elections,
14 which may use it only to ascertain or prove the applicant's identity,
15 or the applicant's eligibility or ineligibility for a state permit,
16 license, loan, or other benefit.

17 * Sec. 3. AS 15.15.400 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 15.15.400. PREPARATION OF VOTER LIST. The director shall
19 prepare both a statewide list and a list by precinct of the names and
20 mailing addresses of all persons who voted in the election and their
21 political party affiliation. Any person may obtain a copy of the
22 list, or a part of the list, or a computer tape containing [BOTH RESI-
23 DENCE AND] mailing addresses of voters, by applying to the director
24 and paying to the state treasury a fee as determined by the director.
