6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the registration of motor
7 vehicles owned by elected state officials."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10.181(f) is amended to read:

10 (f) Vehicles owned by elected state officials. The department
11 shall issue special registration plates to each incumbent elected
12 state official for display on noncommercial motor vehicles owned and
13 driven by the official. The department shall number or design the
14 plates so that registration by an elected state official is indicated
15 upon the plates. The registration plates issued under this subsection
16 remain with the owner of the vehicle only during the official's [HIS]
17 term of office. The department shall maintain in its data processing
18 system records reflecting the identity of the elected official and
19 motor vehicle to which each registration plate under this subsection
20 has been issued.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.421(d) is amended to read:

22 (d) The special registration fees under this subsection are
23 imposed annually, unless otherwise specified, for:

24 (1) an historic vehicle (one time only upon initial regis-
25 tration under AS 28.10.181) \$10;

26 (2) special request plates..... \$20; plus the fee
27 required for that vehicle under (b)(1) or (2) of this section; the fee
28 required by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issu-
29 ance and on the replacement of special request plates;

- 1 (3) a vehicle owned by a disabled veteran or other handi-
2 capped person, and registered under AS 28.10.181 or a resident 65
3 years of age or older who complies with AS 28.10.411(c)..... none;
- 4 (4) a vehicle owned by the state..... none;
- 5 (5) a vehicle owned by an elected state official
6 an amount equal to the amount of the fee required for that vehicle
7 under (b) of this section;
- 8 (6) a vehicle owned by a consular officer, unless waived
9 under AS 28.10.181..... \$30;
- 10 (7) a vehicle owned by a rancher, farmer, or dairyman and
11 registered under AS 28.10.181..... \$30;
- 12 (8) a snowmobile or off-highway vehicle..... \$ 5;
- 13 (9) an amateur mobile radio station vehicle,
14 (A) with a transceiver capable of less than 5-band
15 operation..... the
16 fee required for that vehicle under (b) or (c) of this section;
- 17 (B) in recognition of [HIS] service to the public: a
18 mobile amateur radio station owned by an amateur with general
19 class or higher license, provided the station must be satisfac-
20 torily proved capable of operating on at least five bands between
21 160 through 10 meters, must have an antenna, and must have a
22 power supply and wiring as a permanent part of the vehicle; the
23 transmitting unit may be removed from the car for service or dry
24 storage none
25 for a mobile amateur radio station vehicle included in b(1) or
26 (2) of this section;
- 27 (10) dealer registration plates,
28 (A) the initial set of plates..... \$40;
29 (B) each subsequent set of plates..... \$20;

- 1 (11) a vehicle owned by a municipality or charitable organi-
2 zation meeting the requirements of AS 28.10.181(e)..... \$ 5;
3 (12) an occasional use vehicle under AS 28.10.181(k)... \$15.
