7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the federal government has successfully solicited bids from  
9 airlines on some of the major routes; and

10 WHEREAS travel agencies have expressed an interest in bidding on  
11 heavily traveled routes within the state; and

12 WHEREAS the state could save a large amount of money by seeking bids  
13 for hotels, car rentals, and airline travel; and

14 WHEREAS AS 37.05.230 requires that certain contractual services  
15 purchased by the state be based on competitive bids; and

16 WHEREAS the state could seek competitive bids for travel under  
17 existing statutes;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Department of  
19 Administration is encouraged to require that contracts for travel by state  
20 employees be based on competitive bids.
