BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS accidents in the workplace each year kill about 13,000 Ameri-

cans and injure 2.2 million other American workers; and

WHEREAS accidents in the workplace cost Americans about \$30 billion

annually; and

WHEREAS employers and employees in the public and private sectors

14

should be made aware that a safe workplace contributes to a productive and

15

healthy environment; and

WHEREAS the American Society of Safety Engineers, an organization

17

established in 1911, dedicated to the reduction of workplace accidents and

18

deaths through the training and development of high-skilled professionals

in safety and health management, and with more than 18,000 members in more

20

than 50 countries, will be calling attention to the seriousness and magni-

21

tude of the problem through appropriate activities; and

WHEREAS the reduction of injuries and deaths in the workplace ought to

23

be accomplished with public support and cooperation;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governor is

respectfully requested to designate the week of June 26 - July 2, 1983 as

"Safety in the Workplace Week".
