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IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

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THIRTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

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Relating to the appointment of a Trans-

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portation Safety Task Force.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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WHEREAS the Office of Management and Budget has conducted a

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performance and policy review of the transportation regulatory practices of

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the Alaska Transportation Commission; and

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WHEREAS that review concluded that Alaska's efforts to ensure

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commercial vehicle safety have been sporadic and inconsistent; and

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WHEREAS there is no comprehensive commercial vehicle safety program in

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Alaska; and

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WHEREAS the state should commit to a policy of aggressive commercial

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vehicle safety enforcement; and

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WHEREAS inconsistent safety enforcement has resulted in duplication of

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effort and a lower quality of service;

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BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

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the Governor to appoint a Transportation Safety Task Force to develop a

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comprehensive commercial vehicle safety program that would include repre-

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sentatives from the affected transportation industries, the Governor's

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office, the Alaska Transportation Commission, the division of measurement

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standards of the Department of Commerce, the Department of Public Safety,

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the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, and local and

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municipal agencies involved in commercial vehicle safety enforcement.
