9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Article I, sec. 19, Constitution of the State of Alaska is  
11 amended to read:

12 SECTION 19. RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS. The [ A WELL-REGULATED MILITIA  
13 BEING NECESSARY TO THE SECURITY OF A FREE STATE, THE] right of a  
14 person [THE PEOPLE] to keep and bear arms for defense of self, home  
15 and property, or for lawful hunting and recreational use, or for other  
16 lawful purposes shall not be infringed.

17 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
18 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity  
19 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-  
20 tion laws of the state.
